How to write a **death or funeral notice...**
that celebrates the life of the person who has died

WHAT IS A DEATH NOTICE VS A FUNERAL NOTICE?

The purpose of the Death Notice is to advise family and friends of the death. For some families, this announcement is fairly formal and structured, for others it can be more of a personal tribute. This style of notice generally includes the full name of the deceased person, the date of death and date of birth or age, and family names and relationships.

The Funeral Notice informs friends and family of the day, date, time and place of the funeral as well as instructions regarding the committal, refreshments and donations. This notice usually follows a standard format and includes the Funeral Director's contact details.

IS THAT JUST ANOTHER NAME FOR OBITUARY?

Put simply, yes. Obituaries, which date back thousands of years, are often chosen as a way for families to advertise when a death has occurred and provides information on when and where Funeral Services will take place.

HOW TO WRITE A DEATH OR FUNERAL NOTICE

While our funeral planners are here to help and will ensure notices are placed in the newspaper(s) of your choice, you may wish to write the announcement yourself; some people find the act of writing an obituary for their loved one is a therapeutic tool that helps them cope with difficult emotions associated with their loss and grief.

Whether you prefer for the notice to be formal and structured, or for it to serve as more of a tribute, we understand it is an entirely personal decision and we are here to help you no matter what you choose.

HOW TO LODGE A DEATH OR FUNERAL NOTICE

Your Funeral Planner will be able to assist you with this, and will ensure that Notices are lodged with the newspapers of your choice.

Once approved, determine the channels through which the notice will be distributed. This could include local newspapers, online platforms, and social media.

Tobin Brothers Funerals also offer complimentary Tribute Pages and (provided you have not opted for the details of the Funeral Service to be private and confidential) the Notice you submit will be published on our website.

WHAT IS A TRIBUTE PAGE?

A Tribute Page is a dedicated page on the Tobin Brothers website which displays the Funeral Notice, Service Information, Webcast recording, Order of Service and a Tribute Wall for your loved one. Here, friends and family can view the webcast if the family have chosen to have one, send food or flowers, light virtual candles, share photos and memories and leave condolences and messages of love.

CAN THE FUNERAL DETAILS BE KEPT PRIVATE?

Yes. You could always choose to place a Death Notice but to have the Funeral Service details kept private. Please notify your Funeral Planner if you wish for the Funeral details to be left unpublished and for the Funeral details to remain private. In these instances we will not include the Funeral Service details on our website, we will keep the details confidential over the phone and in correspondence with anyone who enquires and you have the option to have a webcast that remains private with a password also.
